If so please spell them out phonically

How do you want to be announced as a couple? Example: "*Ladies and Gentleman the New Mr. and Mrs. John Doe!*" Or "*Mr. and Mrs. John and Jane Doe!*" Etc.

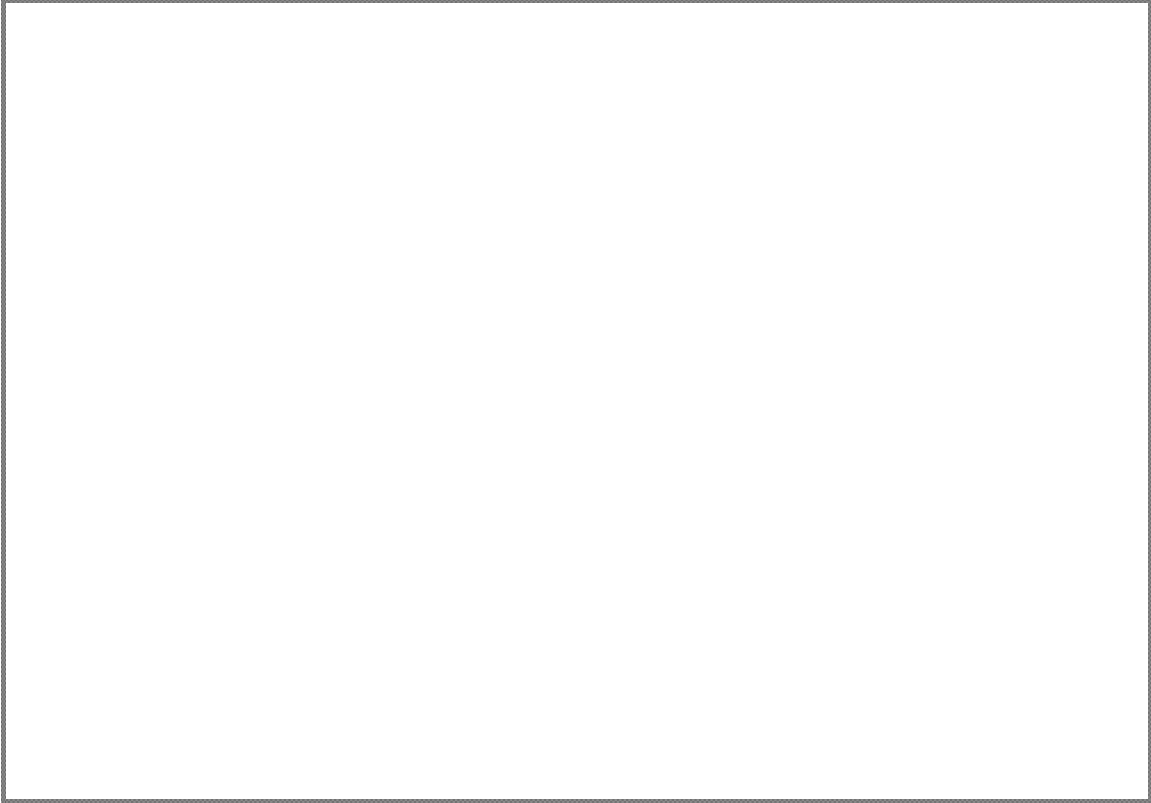
